**How did you get started?**  
I was working in retail management, and reflecting on the job, I recognized that I was spending time talking with people about developing balance between work and life. I decided to leave retail and pursue a career in counseling.

**What training did you have?**  
I have a master's of science in counseling from the University of Southern Maine. While working through my 900-hour internship, I started the licensing process to become an alcohol and drug counselor.

**What is a typical day on the job like?**  
One of the more interesting facets of this field is there is no typical day. While my days primarily consist

of meeting with individuals or facilitating a group, the nature of this work makes each day different from the next.

**What skills do you need on the job?**  
Active listening is most important, to attend to an individual's needs and recognize through both words and body language when they are struggling with an issue. Listening also allows me to employ other important skills, such as using open-ended questions and silence. Empathy is also valuable, since being able to

feel what a person is going through helps develop the relationship with an individual.

**What's your favorite part of the job?**  
Having hope for positive change in my clients, and seeing them start to take committed action in their lives to facilitate this change.

**What's the greatest challenge?**  
I have to be aware when my efforts are not helping someone, and refer them to other services that offer the best chance for success.

**Who succeeds in the job?**  
Someone who can meet people where they are in life. Having your own agenda diverts the focus from where it belongs, which is on the client. Developing balance and having

self-interests are also important, because this work is time-and-energy-consuming.
